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ORDER FOR RELEASE OF MEDICAL
RECORDS AND PROTECTIVE ORDER

Comes now Affiant, having been duly sworn, and testifies as follows:

1. I am legal counsel for The Other Side, Respondent, in the above captioned case.
2. On April 1, 2003, I sent, via certified mail, return receipt requested, the attached Exhibit A to Patient and Patient's Legal Counsel, notifying Patient and Patient's Legal Counsel that I would be subpoenaing portions of Patient's medical record from Provider.
